

Data Policy and Privacy Statement of ThinPrint Cloud Services, Inc.

1. Purpose

ThinPrint Cloud Services, Inc., ("TPCS"), respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through compliance with this Data Policy and Privacy Statement (the "Privacy Statement") and with applicable law. This Privacy Statement covers the Personal Data collection, use and disclosure practices of TPCS websites, products and services that link to this Privacy Statement.

"Personal Data" means any information that identifies or can reasonably be used to identify a natural person.

This Privacy Statement is designed to inform you of:

- how TPCS processes, discloses and transfers your Personal Data, if applicable;
- your choices with regard to how TPCS will use or disclose your Personal Data; and
- your other rights with regard to your Personal Data.

2. Scope

This Privacy Statement does not cover data from which individual persons cannot be identified, or situations in which pseudonyms are used. (The use of pseudonyms involves the replacement of names or other identifiers with substitutes, so that identification of individual persons is not possible).

3. Collection and Use of Personal Data

TPCS may receive Personal Data: (1) directly from you, (2) from an affiliated company or (3) through information that TPCS collects as you navigate through a TPCS website or service, including usage details, IP addresses, and cookies.

TPCS uses your Personal Data for business purposes, including without limitation: (1) order and service fulfillment; (2) customer service; (3) product improvement; (4) storing and processing data, including Personal Data, in computer databases and servers; (5) implementing and maintaining TPCS's information technology; and (6) for other business-related purposes permitted and/or required under applicable local law and regulation. If TPCS intends to use your Personal Data for any purpose not described in this Privacy Statement, TPCS will seek your prior consent.

4. Disclosures/Onward Transfers of Personal Data

TPCS discloses your Personal Data only to those who reasonably need to know such data for a legitimate business purpose, and TPCS requires any third party to whom such disclosures are made to abide by confidentiality obligations. Absent your consent, TPCS will disclose your Personal Data only to service providers who perform tasks on TPCS's behalf and their contractors, provided that such service providers or contractors either: (a) comply with mechanism permitted by the EU Data Protection laws and the applicable laws of other countries that impose international data transfer restrictions or (b) agree to provide adequate protections for your privacy interests that are no less protective than those set out in this Privacy Statement and to use the Personal Data only for the purposes for which the third party has been engaged by TPCS.

TPCS will not sell, rent, give away or otherwise distribute your Personal Data to anyone except as described above. Other than the disclosures described above, TPCS will disclose Personal Data only when required to do so by law, or when TPCS believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of TPCS, third parties or the public at large. If you are a registered user of a TPCS website or service and have supplied your email address, TPCS may, where permitted by law, occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with developments regarding TPCS and its products and services. If you send TPCS a request (for example via a contact form on the website), TPCS reserves the right to make it available to the relevant department at TPCS and/or affiliates companies in order to help us clarify or respond to your request. TPCS may disclose to third parties certain aggregated information collected about you and other users, but such information will not contain any personally identifiable information and your identity will be kept anonymous.

5. Sensitive Data

"Sensitive Data" is data that pertains to a person's racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, income records, health, sexual orientation or alleged commission of any offense. TPCS does not solicit Sensitive Data and will not disclose to any third party Sensitive Data that you have provided and will

not use your Sensitive Data for any purpose other than (1) for the purpose for which you originally provided it, (2) for a purpose you later expressly consented to, or (3) where necessary to fulfill TPCS's legal obligations.

6. Confidentiality and Security of Data

TPCS maintains reasonable physical, administrative and technical safeguards designed to secure your Personal Data and Sensitive Data and to prevent unauthorized access to such information. 7. Right to Access, Change or Delete Data

Upon reasonable request and to the extent the request does not compromise the protections set forth in this Privacy Statement, TPCS allows you reasonable access to your Personal Data and Sensitive Data to correct, amend or delete such data. TPCS will endeavor to respond in a timely manner to all reasonable written requests to view, modify or delete Personal Data or Sensitive Data.

8. Use of Cookies

Our websites use cookies. A cookie is a text-only string of information that a website transfers to a file on the browser on your computer's hard drive so that the website can remember who you are. A cookie will typically contain the name of the domain from which the cookie has come, the "lifetime" of the cookie, and a value, usually a randomly generated unique number. This helps TPCS to provide you with a better experience when you browse our websites and also allows us to improve our sites and services.

We may use cookies in the following ways:

- Where they are essential to make our websites work;
- To enable personalization features on our websites (which give you the ability to recall recently viewed pages and see information which you have input on line); and
- To compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how users use our websites and to help us improve the structure of our websites.

We cannot personally identify you in this way.

11. Changes to this Privacy Statement

This Privacy Statement is current as of the effective date set forth below. TPCS reserves the right to change this Privacy Statement from time to time, consistent with applicable data protection and privacy laws and principles. Unless such changes afford greater protections to your privacy interests, or you otherwise consent, such changes will apply only to Personal Data received after the effective date of such change. You should refer to this Privacy Statement regularly, as it will be updated from time to time.

When TPCS deems it appropriate, other forms of notice may be also given concerning any changes to this Privacy Statement.
